



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Comrs. to me directed bearing date the 5th. ^{11th}/_{mo.} 1702 to Resurvey all such tracts & parcels of Land within the County of Bucks as may be reasonably suspected to have been unduely surveyed when first taken up and have not yet been rectified. Resurveyed unto Basillean Foster a tract of land in Soulbarry township in the sd. County beginning at a white oak by the river Delaware at George Pownall's Corner. Then by the sd. Pownall's line S.W. by W. 132 perches to a black oak. Then by the sd. line West 400 perches to a black oak, Then by Randal Speakman's land North 176. perches to a black oak at Richard Burgess Corner, Then by the sd. Burgess land East 259 perches to a small black oak. Then North 100 perches to a small white oak by the sd. River. Then down the several courses thereof to the place of beginning. Contain-
ing 547 acres. Resurveyed the 29th. day of the 9th. month 1703.
