



In pursuance of a warrant from the Commiss^{rs}. of Property dated the 25th. of July Ano. Domi. 1717 to Survey unto Jeremiah Langhorn of the County of Bucks one thousand acres of Land in the sd. County being part of three thousand acres purchased of the Proprietary by George Beal [near Guilford in great Brittain] Surveyed and laid out unto the sd. Jeremiah Langhorn a tract of Land in Hilton township. in the sd. County of Bucks. Beginning at a small white oak in a line of Charles Brogden's Land. being a Corner of another tract of the sd. Jeremiah's Land from thence extending by the sd. other tract South East two hundred & fifty perches to a Hickory tree. Then by vacant Land South West three hundred and twenty perches to another Hickory tree. Then by vacant Land North West two hundred & fifty pches. to a black oak. Then by William Baldwin's & Charles Brogden's Land North East three hundred & twenty perches to the place of beginning. Containing five hundred acres in part of the sd. 1000 acres.
