

Pursuant to a warrant under the hands of the Commissioners of property and the seal of the Province bearing date the 30th. day of the fourth Month 1702.

There is Resurveyd unto John Large a Tract of land in Buckingham township in the County of Bucks beginning at a post by a small white oak at the Corner of Richard Lundies Land from thence by the said land and by — Burges and — Smith's Land south west three hundred thirty six perches to a black oak sapling from thence by vacant land north west fifty one perches to a heap of Stones by a white oak sapling from thence by William SAYS land North east two hundred thirty six perches to a post in James Streater's line from thence by thence by the said Streater's land south east fifty one perches to the place of the beginning Containing One hundred and seven acres Resurveyd by Jno. Cutler the 8th. of 8 br. 1702.
