up according to the Method of Towneships appointed by the
Governor. They Seating and Improveing The Same according
to the Regulation above mentioned within Six Months after
the Date of Survey and make Returne hereof to the Secre-
tarys office Dated at Philadelphia The 11th. of the 6th. Month
1686.
