Edward Lucas and Gilbert Wheeler of the sd. place about the Division Line or Lines between them, then to associate to thy self a sufficient Number of the good men of the Neighbourhood and by their best advice and Judgem^t. to run the sd Line or Lines and make Returns into ye General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warr^t. is to remain and a copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philad^{ia}. the 4th. of ye 3^d. Moth.
