 Original Purchaser of five hundred Acres of Land in this Province
 that we would Grant him to take up his said Purchase. These are
 to Authorize and Require thee to survey or cause to be Survey'd
 to the said Thomas Cam according to the Method of Townships
 appointed the said quantity of five hundred Acres of Land in
 this Province that has not been already Survey'd nor taken up nor
 is conceal'd nor Seated by the Indians, and make Returns
 thereof into the Secretaries Office. Given under our hands
 and Seal of the Province at Philad^a the 28th day of the
 third Month in the sixth Year of the Reign of Queen Anne of
 Great Britain &c. A.D. 1707.
