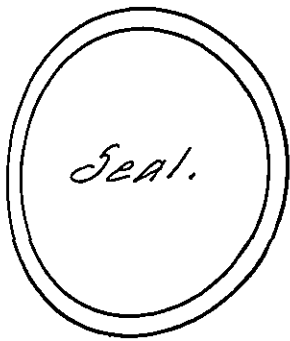


PENNSYLVANIA S.S.

Acres of Land in part of two hundred and fifty Acres devised
by Isaac Decow Purchaser of Two thousand and five hundred
Acres unto his Daughter Susannah of whose assigns the said
Jeremiah Purchased the sd one hundred and fifty acres.

These are to Authorize thee to survey or cause to be survey'd
to the said Jeremiah Langhorn according to the Method of
Townships appointed the said quantity of One hundred and
fifty Acres of Land in this Province that have not been already
Survey'd nor taken up nor are seated by the Indians and make
Return thereof into ye Secretaries Office. Given under our
hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad^a the 17th day
of October A. D. 1713.
