



By virtue of a warrant from Jacob Taylor Surveyr Gen<sup>l</sup> to me directed pursuant to a warrant from the Commrs. of Property dated the fourth day of the second month 1707 Surveyed & laid out unto Matthew Grange a Tract of Land in Buckingham township in Bucks County beginning at a Post at Nathaniel Bye's Corner from thence South East by Uno Starbrough & Uno Bye's Land one hundred Eighty two perches to a small Hickory. Then by vacant land South West Eighty Eight perches to a Post, Then by vacant land North West one hundred Eighty two perches to a Post in the sd. Nathaniel Bye's line. Then by the sd Line North East Eighty eight perches to the place of beginning. Containing one hundred acres & sixteen perches Surveyed the 25<sup>th</sup> day of the 7<sup>th</sup> month 1710.
