



By virtue of a Warrant from the Commrs. of Property bearing date the 20th day of the first month 1715/6 Surveyed & laid out unto Joseph Growdon Esqr. A certaine tract of Land in the great Swamp in Bucks County [or Richland], beginning at a Post by a white oak at the South west Corner of John Edwards Land. From thence extending West by vacant Land four hundred & forty perches to an Ash tree. Then by vacant Land North five hundred & Eighty perches to a white oak marked for a Corner. Then East by vacant Land, four hundred perches to a white oak. Then againe by vacant Land South four hundred & twenty perches to a white oak. Then East forty perches to a small white oak at the other Corner of the sd. John Edwards Land. Then by the sd. Edwards Line South one hundred & sixty perches to the beginning. Containing one thousand four hundred & Ninety acres. Laid out the 2d. day of the 6th. month 1716.
