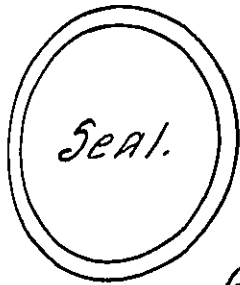


PENNSYLVANIA S.S.

 much be found Due to him] and make ^a returne thereof
 into the Secretary's Office Given under our hands and
 Seale of the Province at Philadelphia the twenty Sixth day
 of the Third Month Anno Dni. 1714.
