



By virtue of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property to me directed bearing date the 19th day of the 3^d month 1702 Resurveyed unto William Garret of Darby a Tract of Land lying near Warminster in the County of Bucks, Beginning at a Post in William Pickerin's Line, being the Corner of Thomas Atkinson's Land, Thence by the said Land S. 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 505 perches to a Post 3 pole distant S. E. from a black oak marked W. G., Then by Arthur Cook's land N. W. 70 per. to a Post by a Spring head, Then by Benjamin East's land N. E. 470 per. to a Post in the said Pickerin's Line by a white oak marked W. G. Then by the said Line South 34 per. to a Corner marked black oak, Then East 84 per. to the place of beginning Containeing 225 Acres, Resurveyed the 23^d day of the 9th month 1702.
