These are therefore in ye Proprietarys name to will and Re-quire thee to Survey or Cause to be Surveyd unto him ye said Number of acres in ye afore said Savanna ~~who~~ and make Returns here off to ye Secretarys office Dated at Philadel-phia ye 12th Sixth Month 1687.
