



By virtue of a warrant from the Proprietaries Comms. to me directed bearing date the 10th ^{1st}/_{mo}. 170 $\frac{1}{2}$ to execute all warrants directed to Phineas Pemberton and not executed And pursuant to a warrant from Edward Penington Surveyr. Genl. to the sd. Phineas Pemberton bearing date the 10th ^{9th}/_{mo}. 1701. Surveyed and layd out unto Robert Heath in right of Thomas Woolrich old purchaser of 1000 Acres. A Tract of Land in Soulbury Township in Bucks County Beginning at a corner marked black oak by the River Delaware, Thence West by vacant Land five hundred and twenty four perches to a Post by a broken white oak in the Lin. of the Great Spring Tract. Then by the sd. Tract North East one hundred and sixty perches to two black oak saplings dead. Then North West by the same Eighty Eight perches to a Post. Then by the sd. Robert Heath's other tract East four hundred Seventy five perches to a Post by the said River. Then down the several courses of the same to the place of Beginning. Containing five hundred Acres Layd out the first day of the fifth month. 1703.
