



By virtue of a Warrant from the Commrs of Property to me directed bearing date the 8<sup>th</sup> <sup>11<sup>th</sup></sup>/<sub>mo</sub> 1702 to Resurvey unto John Morris a certaine Tract of Land in Southampton township in the County of Bucks Laid out for 582 ac. part of 600 ac. purchased by Thomas ffairman of Allen ffoster original purchaser of Eleven hundred acres. The said Tract of land Beginning at a Post at William Gregory's Corner Thence by the Proprietaries land North West 288 perches to an Ash at John Rush's Corner Then by the said Rush's land North East 320 per. to a black oak in George Willard's line. Then by the said Willard's Land South East 286 per. to a white Oak at William Gregory's other Corner Then South West by the said Gregory's Land 318 perches to the place of Beginning Containing 572 Acres. Resurveyed the 23<sup>d</sup>. <sup>12<sup>th</sup></sup>/<sub>mo</sub> 1702. By me John Cutler.
