Whereas Thomas Hudson hath desired of mee a Warrant for five
thousand Acres of Land which hee hath bought over above his
one thousand Acres of Land which he formerly purchased.

These are therefore to will & require thee forthwith to survey or
cause to bee survey'd unto ye said Thomas Hudson or order
said five thousand Acres of Land in one Tract as near as may bee
to his aforesaid one thousand Acres. Given at London the twenty
sixth day of the 12^{mo}. 1684. it being the first yeare of the Raigne
of King James the 2^d. and the fourth of that Government.
