

Whereas there is a Certain tract of land lying & being in the County of Bucks Beginning at a Cornr tree standing in the division line between the Countys of Philadelphia & Bucks, Alford. thence running by the Alford line North west one thousand two hundred & Eight perches to a Cornr. oak standing in the Alford line. Thence North East six hundred & forty prhs. by a line of Marked trees to A Corner tree. Thence South East one thousand two hundred & Eight prhes. p_{tly}. by land then untaken up and p_{tly} by the Society land to another Cornr. tree being a Cornr. of Randall Blackshaw's land. Thence South west six hundred & forty prhes. to the first mentioned Cornr. tree, Containing & laid out for five thousand Acres of land which sd. land William Penn, propriety & Governr. of the Alford province did grant & confirm unto Thomas Hudson in free simple by Indentures of Lease & release bearing date the twenty third & twenty fourth days of April Andoni, 1683. And was surveyed & laid ~~out~~ out unto the sd. Thomas Hudson in the sd. place by vertue of a warrant under the hand of the sd. propriety dated & seal, the twenty sixth Day of the twelfth Month Andoni, 1684.
