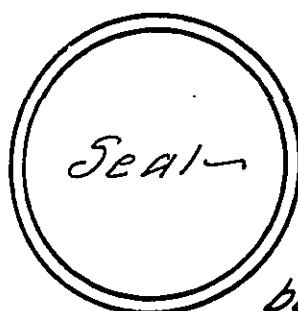


Pensilvania.

These are to Authorize & Require Thee to Survey and lay out to the sd Denis Honders Two hundred and Seventy five Acres of Land, out of some Overplus or vacancy beyond Germantown where it can most conveniently be taken, and where it belongs to the Proprietary to dispose of. And make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia, where this Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delivered to thee Certified by the Secretary. Given under our Hands & the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia, 19<sup>th</sup>. 3<sup>mo</sup>. 1702.
