



By virtue of a warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing Date the 27<sup>th</sup> Day of the 11<sup>th</sup> Month 1719/20 Surveyed and laid out for Hans Nime a Certain Tract of Land Scituate Near Oley in the County of Philadelphia Beginning at a Post Standing in Anthony Lee's Line. Thence by The Same South East one hundred perches and by vact Land the Same Course Twenty perches to a white oak Tree Marked for a Corner Thence by vact. Land North East One hundred forty and one perches to a Post Thence by vact. Land North West One hundred and Twenty perches to a Large white Oak Marked for a Corner Thence by vact Land South West one hundred forty & one perches to the place of beginning Contain- ing One hundred Acres with Allowance of Six p Cent. Surveyed June the third Day 1720.
