By the Commissioners of Property.

At the Request of Hans Keym late of Germany but now of this Province that we would Grant him to take up one hundred Acres of Land at Oley for which he agrees to pay to the use of the Trustees of the Province ffifteen pounds Money thereof and the yearly quitrent of one Shilling Sterling for the Same These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Surveyed unto the said Hans Keym in ye place aforesaid according to the method of Townships appointed the said one hundred Acres of Land that has not been already Survey'd nor appropriated nor is Seated by the Indians and make Returns thereof into the Secretarys Office which Survey in case the said Hans Keym fulfill the above agreement within three Months after the date hereof shall be valid otherwise the same is to be void as if it had never been made nor this warrant ever granted. Given under our hands & the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 27th day of ye 11th Month Anno Dni. 1719 ²⁰
