At ye Request of William Hills Purchaser yt I would grant him to take up Two hundred & fifty Acres of Land in ye County of Philadelphia. These are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him beyond Skul-Kill on ye North side of Darbey Creek ye sd. Number of Acres in a place not already taken up according to ye method of Townships appointed by me. & make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office Given at Philadel-phia ye 24th mo. 7st. 1683.
