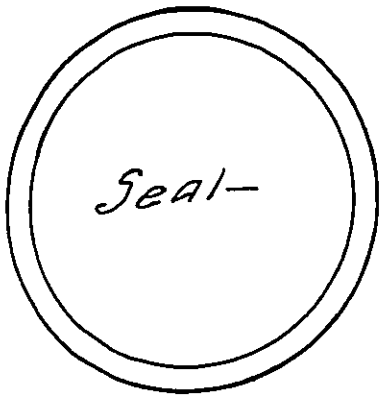


Pensilvania

By the Commission^{rs} of Property.

At the Request of Mordcrai Moore and Willm. Biles. That we would grant them to take up Seven hundred and fifty Acres of Land [over and above the quantity of one thousand Acres already taken up] in right and part of two thousand five hundred Acres the Original Purchase of ffrancis Plumsted of London. These are to Authorize and Require thee forthwith to Survey and lay out to the sd. ffrancis Plumsted according to the Method of Townships appointed, the said quantity of Seven hundred and fifty Acres of Land that has not been already Survey'd nor taken up nor is conceal'd nor seated by the Indians, and make Returns into the General Surveyor's Office at Philadia. where this Warrnt is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands & Seal of the Province at Philadia. the 26th of the 4th Moth. 1704.
