

By virtue of a Warrant from the Commiss^{rs}. of Property bearing date the 28th. of ye 2^{mo}. 1702 for Resurveying unto Abel Noble a Certain Tract of Land Laid out in Warminster on Neshaminkh Creek for Sevenⁿ hundred and fifty Acres to Nathaniel Allen in right and as part of his Original Purchase of two thousand Acres but now by several Conveyances in the said Abel's possession.

Resurvey'd the said Tract beginning at a post standing at the Corner of a Tract of Land Laid out to William Bingley. Thence by Philadelphia County Line ~~to~~ North West three hundred and fifty six perches two a white Oak. Thence by the Land of Henry English North East three hundred and eleven perches to a post. Thence by the Lands of George Randal and John Hart South East two degrees East three hundred and fifty six perches to a post by a small Hickery. Thence South West by the aforesaid William Bingley's Land three hundred and eighteen perches to the place of Beginning. Containing Six hundred and Ninety seven Acres and forty six perches.

Resurvey'd the 24th. of the 6^{mo}. 1703 by John Cutler.
