



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Comms. to me directed bearing date the 28th. /<sup>20</sup>mo 1702 to resurvey unto Abel Noble a Tract of Land in Warminster laid out to Nathaniel Allen. Resurveyed the said Tract unto the said Abel Noble. Beginning at a Post at the Corner of a Tract laid out to William Bingley. Thence by Philadelphia County line N. W. 356 perches to a white oak, Then by Henry English Land N. E. 311 perches to a Post in George Randal's line. Then by the sd. Randal & John Hart's Land S. E. 2 degs. E. 356 perches to a Post by a small Hickery. Then by sd. Bingley's land S. W. 318 perches to the place of beginning Containing 697 ac. 46 per. Resurveyed the 24th. /<sup>6</sup>th. mo. 1703.
