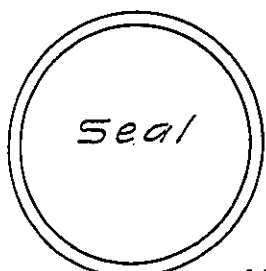

At the request of Edmond M<sup>#</sup>Veagh that we would grant him a resurvey on a certain tract of land in his possession situate in the middle ~~part~~ Dublin township in the County of Philadia. consisting of one parcel purchased of Peter Bainton (being part of Will<sup>m</sup> Stanley's purchase) for 250 acres and two <sup>other</sup> several parcels purchased of Silas Crispin containing in both 101 acres, reputed to contain in the whole three hundred and fifty one acres. These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey the said whole tract in one according to the first lines thereof extending the same to the westmost side of line of the old Sasquehannagh road comprehending also and taking in the sd road as much as lies between the lines thereof and make returns into the General Surveyors office at Philadia. where this warrant is to remain and a copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by ye Secretary. Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philad<sup>ia</sup> 26<sup>th</sup> of October 1702.
