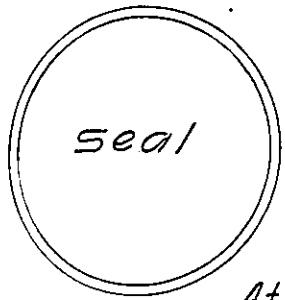


Pensylvania
