These are to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye sd number of acres in ye County of Philadelphia where not already taken up according to ye method of townships appointed by me and make returns thereof into my Secretarys office. Given at Philadelphia ye 23^d 5th mo. 1683.
