At ye request of John Marsh, purchaser of one thousand  
acres yt I would grant him to take up his lotts in ye City of  
Philadelphia. These are to will and require thee forthwith  
to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye lotts where fell  
and make returns thereof into my Secretary's office.

Given at Philadelphia, ye 14<sup>th</sup> of the 12<sup>th</sup> mo. 1683.
