At ye request of Humphry Murrey y^e I would grant an addition of twelve foot of ~~the~~ ground to ye thirty foot in ye front of Delaware he bought of Thomas Philips, Atturney of Mercy Jefferson. These are to will, & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye sd number of feet adjoyning to ye sd Mercy Jefferson's lott and make returns thereof into my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia ye 11th 12th mo. 1683.
