At ye request of Richard Marsh purchaser of ten thou-
sand acres yt we would grant him to take up his land wthin
ye liberties proportionable. These are in ye Proprietary's
name to will and require thee forthwth to survey or cause to
be survey'd unto him his proportion of land wthin ye bounds
thereof & make returns thereof into ye Secretary's office.
