


By warts from the Govern^t to me directed to survey unto Eriffith Jones one hundred acres in the City liberties and abl. unto John Moore Sabian Coles Thomas Burkner Humphry south & Samuel Jobson each twenty acres being a hundred acres as their proportions of purchases in the City liberties I hereby authorize thee to survey & set out unto them the said quantities of lands adjoining to the societys lands and so up that small creek & let it be contiguous to Eriffith Jones five hundred acres if possible at least his own proportion of the City liberties ~~as~~ as much thereof as the place will admitt and all layd out in a reasonable square & so contiguous that there be no vacancy betwixt but that others may be fitly placed after, and make me a returne of the originall field work & protracted figure which are to remain on record in my office.
