him a warrant to take up his City lott according to  
his purchase of two hundred & fifty acres in this City  
of Philadelphia.

These are to will and require thee forthwith to survey  
or cause to be survey'd unto him in ye street appointed for  
ye purchasers of ye like quantity his lott within this City  
and make returns thereof into my Secretarys office.

Given at Philadelphia ye 24<sup>th</sup> of ye 1<sup>st</sup> mo. 1683.
