By the Commissioners of Property.

At the request of Richard Jones of Parkeominick in the County of Philad^a that we would grant him a certain piece of land jayning to his own settlement on the east side of the land of Edw^d Lane, deod containing one hundred & eighty acres for which he agrees to pay to the Propriet^rs use fforty pounds for the same and the yearly quitrent of one Skill^g sterl. for ye hundred acres & in like proportion for the eighty acres & also if upon the survey there should be more land than ye quantity of one hundred & eighty acres that then the sd Rich^d _____ is to pay for every acre over and above the number five skill^g and the same quitrent with the rest. These are to authorize & require thee to survey or cause to be surveyed unto the said Rich^d Jones in the place aforesd. the sd quantity of one hundred & eighty acres of land or more if there be any in the vacancy not being already surveyed nor appropriated and make a return thereof into the Secretarys office which survey in case the sd Richard _____ pay down to the Propriet^rs use on the 16th day of the next third month twenty pounds and the remainder on the 16th day of the next 9th month with six months interest shall be valid otherwise the same is to be voyd as if it had never been made nor this warrant ever granted Given under our hands & seal of the Province of Philad^a the 3^d day of the first month Anno Dom-1715
