
Laid out to Humphry Thomas one hundred acres of land beginning at a corner post beginning a corner of a tract of land of Humphry Ellis and by the sd Ellis line of trees marked north north west four hundred perches to a corner stake from thence wobl. south west forty perches to a corner post from thence south south east four hundred perches to a stake from thence East north East forty perches to the place of beginning containing & laid out for one hundred acres of land & laid out the twelfth of the 5<sup>th</sup> month last past & is accordingly returned into the Survey<sup>r</sup> Generall's office by virtue of a warrant from the Comisn<sup>r</sup>'s bearing date.

Cap<sup>t</sup> Markam Thomas Ellis requests of thee to grant a patent for thiobl. tract of land above sd because he is concerned for the man & he wobl. if possible have it to send in this ship & Robert Longshar being receip obl. of certifieing at present would in treat thee to accept of this & he obl. certiefy it when he is able, this from thy obledged friend & servant.
