

By virtue of a warrant from the Commiss^{rs} of Property bearing date the 16th day of the 12th month 1701, there was survey'd unto Owen Thomas in right of of Henry Sanders a tract ^{of land} within the township of Gosher in the County of Chester, beginning at a corner of a tract of land laid out for William Burge and Company and running by the same south south east three hundred seventy four perches to a post at another corner of the said land thence west south west by a line of marked trees one hundred and ten perches to a black oak sappling thence north north west three hundred seventy four perches to post thence east north east one hundred and ten perches to the place of beginning containⁱⁿg two hundred and fifty seven acres survey'd the 16th of the first month 1704.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this sixth day of April 1909
