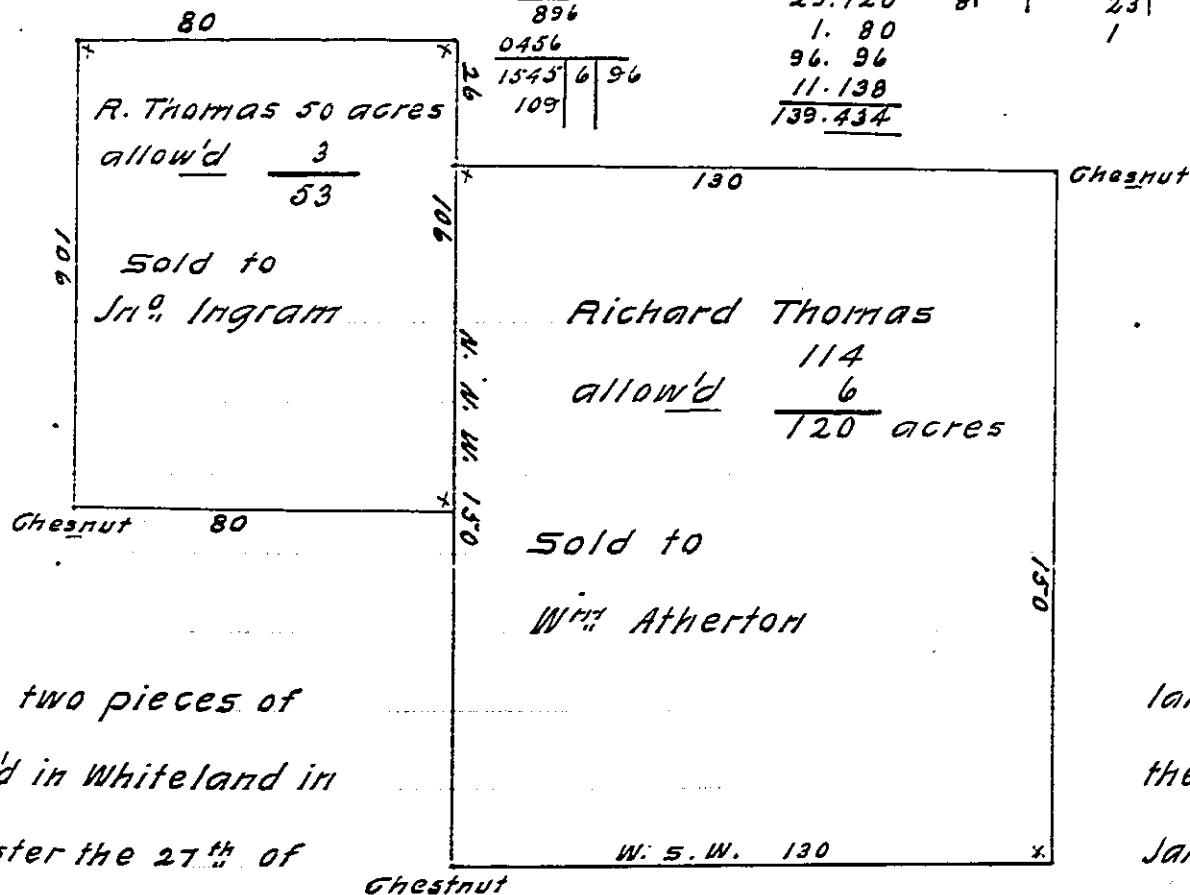

These two pieces of land were surveyed in Whiteland in the County of Chester the 27th of January 1729-30. At the request of Richard Thomas but he having before taken up and sold all the land due to him by his fathers purchase of 5000^a at his request ye 133-above was granted to Thomas Atherton by warrant from the Propriet^{rs} dated ye 31st of Janu^{ry} 1734 and returned into the Secretarys office the 29th of March 1735. See the survey & record of the return.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this sixth day of April 1909
