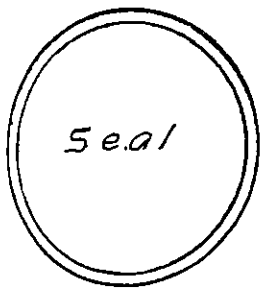

In pursuance of our ord^{rs} formerly to thee given these are to require thee forthwith to compleat the resurvey or subdivision of two thousand acres of land to Richard Thomas in such places or places within the Welch tract as were formerly laid out or appropriated to him or wh^{ch} thou finds vacant and not yet subdivided in pursuance of the General warr^t for laying out the same w^{ch} said two thousand acres are in right and as part of five thousand acres originally purchased by Richard ap Thomas father to ye sd Richard — and make return of thy sd survey or surveys into the General Surveyors office at Philad^{ia} where this warr^t is to remain and a copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by ye secretary. Given under our hands and ye seal of ye Province at Philad^{ia} the 4th of ye 6th moth 1702.
