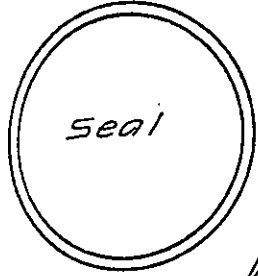

Whereas Mary Edwards formerly Hickman who came into this Province at the first settling of it a servant to Jn^o Hardin and James Widowes who came a servant to Jn^o Bezer and Margaret Ven formerly Smith who came in a serv^t to Richard ffew and Christian Puller formerly Steward who came a serv^t to Nathan^l Allen and W^m Thomas who came a serv^t to Thomas Barker but served Rob^t Wade having by their servitude each of them a right to fifty acres of Head land, have by their deeds duly executed assigned and made over to Isaac Taylor, Surveyor all their said respective rights and interest therein whereupon the s^d Isaac — hath requested that we would grant him a warr^t for taking up the same. These therefore are to authorize thee to survey to the said Isaac Taylor in the rights aforesaid the quantity of two hundred and fifty acres of land in this Province that has not been already survey'd nor taken up nor is concealed nor seated by the Indians and make returns into the General Surveyors office at Philad^{ia} where this warr^t is to remain and a copy thereof to be del^{vd} to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands & seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 8th of the first month 1705⁶
