Pursuance to a warrant from the Commiss^{rs} of prop^{ty} directed unto me bearing date ye 13 of ye 12th mo. 1701. I do certiefy that I have reasurveyd unto Rachel Wharton by ye name of Rachel Ellis a certaine tract of land in Harford in ye County of Chester begining at the whitt ok above ~~and falls~~ being a corner of Morris Lwelins land by a smal branch of ye Mill Creek from thence by the sevrall courses of the same 90 perches to a stak set in ye ground being a corner of Ellis Ellis land from thence west south west by a line of trees & ye same land 39 perches to a stak set in ye ground thence by a line of marked trees deviding it from ye reputed land of Bridgeart Ellis North North West 56 perches to a chestnut marked thence by a line of marked trees East North East 228 perches to a stak in the line of Benjamin Humphrys land from thence by a line of marked trees & ye same land S.
