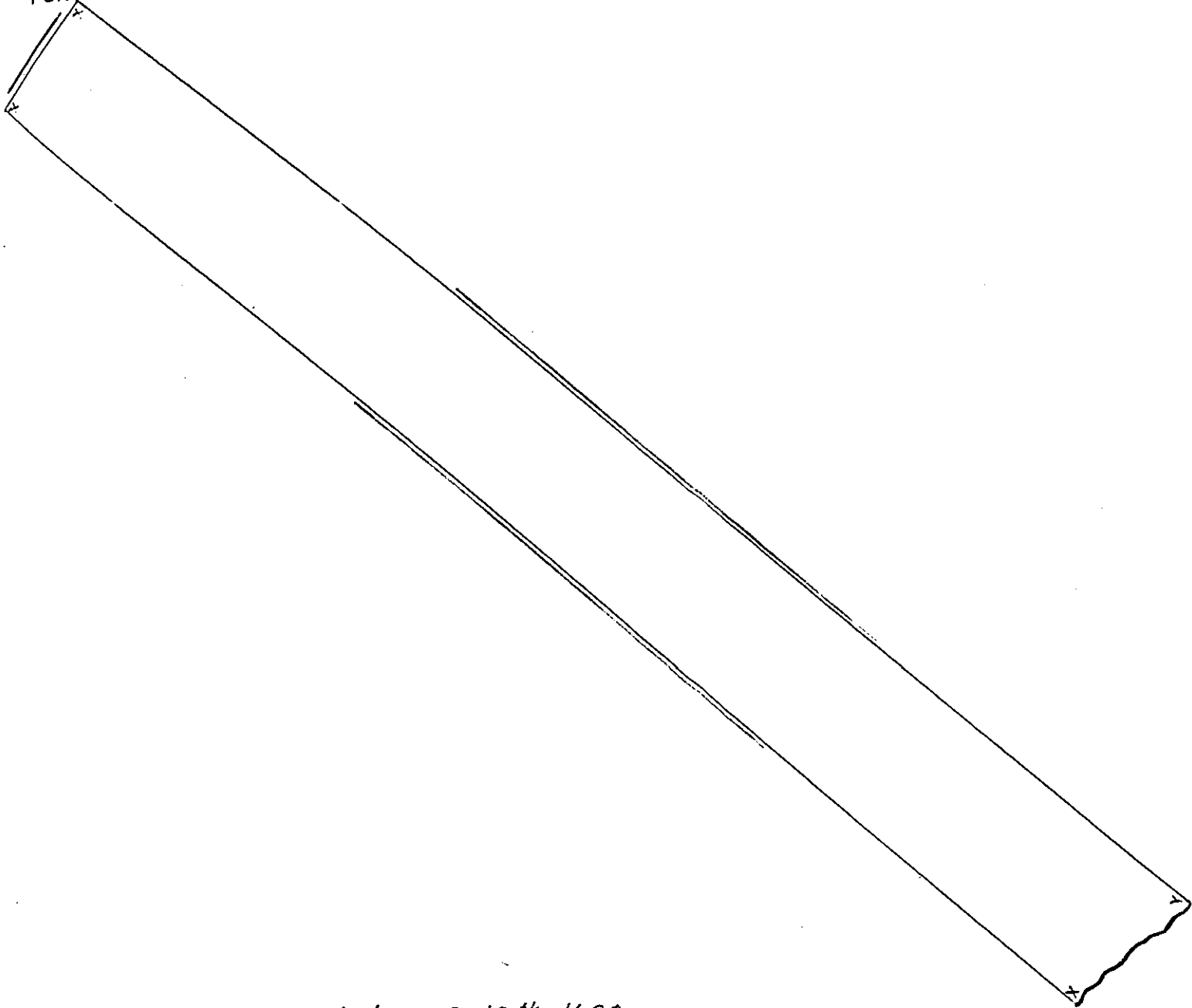

Layd out for Thomas Whidbey one hundred and fifty acres of land called Lezion lying on the west side of darbey creek begining at a marked red oke standing by the sd creek sid being one of Joseph Potts corner tree and runing S.S.E. 20 perches to a marked gum from thence W.S.W. into the woods to a marked whitte oke from thence N.N.W. to a marked Chesnutte tree from thence to a marked whitt oke oke E.N.E. standing by darbey creek from thence doune the sd creek to the first marked tree.
