April 6th 1683.

Laid out for Robert Wade 236 acres lying on the west side of upland creek and ~~beginning~~ beginning at W^m Woodmansey's corner marked red oak standing by upland creek and running W. S. W. 230 per^{ch} ~~to a~~ along the sd Woodmansey his line of marked trees to a corner post from thence S. S. E. 184 per^{ch} to a marked ~~post~~ ^{oak} from thence E. N. E. 76 per^{ch} to a marked red oak from thence N. E. 140 per^{ch} to a white oak standing by the head of a branch from thence running downe the sd branch on severall coarses to upland creek and up the sd creek on severall coarses to the first marked corner of Will Woodmansey's land where first begun.
