By virtue of a warrant from Captⁿ Thomas Holmes, Surveyor General, they surveyed for Mary Woodard and Ann Barrow 100 acres of land lying on the west side of Scool creek beginning at a marked poplar being a marked corner tree of John Goodwin and running N. W. 134 perch to a marked red oak from thence W. 104 perch to a marked white oak from thence S. 122 perch to a marked red oak from thence E. b. N. 198 perch to the first marked tree.
