

Surveyd the 4th of the 4th month 1717 by virtue of the Comm^{rs} Warrt. dated the 16th of the 3^d month 1717. unto Nicholas White a certain tract of land in Boshem in the County of Chester for w^{ch} he agreed to pay to the Proprietors use after the rate of fifteen pounds p hundred acres beginning at a black oak at a cor^{ne} of William Hudsons land thence north twenty five degrees west by the land of Edward James one hundred and eighty p ches to a small hickery tree then north oblty five degrees easterly two hundred ~~sixty three~~^{thirty six} p ches to a obl oak then south twenty five degobl easterly one hundred obl eighty p ches to a small hickery then south sixty five degobl westerly by the said W^m Hudsons land two hundred obl six p ches to the place of place of beginning contain obl two hundred and fifty acres and an allowance of six p obl t. Returned into the oblary's office May 16th 1718. Jacob Taylor
