At ye request of Robert Taylor on behalf of Peter & Joshua Worrall, purchasers of five hundred acres of land in Pennsylvania yt I would grant y^m to take up part thereof. These are to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be survey^d unto them three hundred acres in ye County of Chester in a place not already taken up according to the method of townships appointed by me & make returns thereof into my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia ye 30th of ye 4th mo^o 1683.
