At ye request of Richard Marshall y<sup>e</sup> I would grant him to  
take up a lott in ye City of Philadelphia to build & settle upon  
it. These are to will & require thee forthw<sup>th</sup> to survey or cause to  
be survey'd unto him a lott as near to his brothers lott & hig-  
street as may be he fencing it in & building upon ye same w<sup>th</sup> in  
six months from ye date of survey and make returns thereof  
into my Secretarys office. Given at Philadelphia ye 29<sup>th</sup>  
of ye 5<sup>th</sup> month 1684
