Surveyed for Thomas Worth 250 acres of land lying in the township of darby beginning at a marked white oak standing by the creekside being the corner mark of Samuel Bradshaws land and running along the sd Bradshaws line E.N.E. 122 perch to a marked poste from thence S.S.E. 16 perch to a marked poste then E.N.E. 390 perch to a marked red oak standing by Mill Creek then up the sd creek on severall courses to a ~~white~~ white oak from thence W.S.W. 470 perch to a marked red oak standing by darby creek then down the creek on severall courses to the first menched white oak
