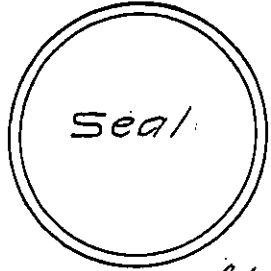

By the Commissioners of Property.

At the request of Anthony Morris of Philadelphia that we would grant him to take up within the liberties of Philadelphia the proportion of liberty land belonging to the original purchase of five hundred acres ~~of land~~ made of the Propriet^r by Sarah Harsent by deeds dated ye 7th & 8th of Sept^r Anno — 1681 and since by her granted to the said Anthony Morris and also that the City lott already laid out in the same right might be resurvey'd and an addition made thereunto which may make the said lott the same dimensions with other lotts laid out in right of purchasses of the like quantity. These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be survey'd unto the said Anthony Morris in the said liberties of Philadelphia the proportion of liberty land appurtenant to the said purchase of five hundred acres if the same may be found clear of all lawfull surveys & claims and also to resurvey the said lott of ground and make such an addition to the same as may make it of like proportion with other lotts laid out in right of purchasses of the same quantity and make returns thereof into the Secretarys office in order for a further confirmation.
