By the Commissioners of Property

At ye request of Anthony Morris of ye City of Philadelphia that wee would grant him a resurvey on a certain tract of land scituate in ye County of Philadelphia first laid out to Sarah Harsent for ffive hundred acres who purchased ye same of ye Proprietary by deeds of lease & release bearing date ye 7th & 8th days of September Anno — 1681. and since by like deeds dated ye 6th & 7th days of ye month called February Anno — 1716. She ye sd Sarah — hath granted and conveyed ye same unto ye sd Anthony Morris. These are to authorize & require ye to resurvey or cause to be resurveyed unto ye sd Anthony Morris ye sd tract of land according to ye first lines & bounds thereof and make exact returns of ye same into ye Secretarys office in order for a further confirmation. Given under our hands & seal of ye Province of Philadelphia ye first day of ye third month Anno Dni. 1717
