



Nazareth Tract.

Jr^o. Oteley's & Henry Antis's Land was surveyed by Nich^o Scull Jun^r. about the year 1750 or 51. — After that Edw^d Scull surveyed for the Prop^{rs} part of each tract Viz^t: from A to B 247 pers^e from B to C 200 pers^e, from C to D 75 pers^e & from D. to A. 142 pers^e leaving 39 pers^e of Oteley's Peice out of the Proprietaries Survey, which is Vacant & claimed by Jr^o. Biddle on a Survey made on an Old right.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty-sixth day of May 1909
