



In pursuance of a law passed the 11th day of April 1799 for the selling certain Reserved tracts of land therein named, the Instructions of the late Governor dated 14th May 1799 and the order of the Surveyor General dated the 18th day of May 1799, Surveyed the 9th day of November 1799, the above described Tract of Land being Lot No 11 (and reserved for the use of Schools) in the Reserved Tract called Franklin in (now) Venango County. Containing five hundred and eleven acres, and one hundred and fifty three perches, strict measure
