

In pulsuance of a law passed the 11th day of April 1799, for selling certain Reserved Tracts of Land there in named, the instructions of the Late Governor dated the 14th day of May 1799, and the Order of the Surveyor General dated the 18th day of May 1799, Surveyed the 12th day of Novemobl, 1799, the above described Tract of Land, being No. 2 of the Reserved obl called Waterford (now) Erie County Containing eighty six acres obl ten perches strict measure.
